- Exhibitors are needed at the Worthington Community Recreation Center, Sarah Jane Workman, Community Liaison, will canvas new members for interest in exhibiting.
- The May speaker for the general meeting will be artist Ruth Ann Mitchell.
- The balance in the WAAL checking account as of 03/31/23 is \$7,798.36. Recent expenditures: \$100 for Michael McEwen, judge for the Spring Virtual Show and \$100 for Tom Hale, the general meeting speaker for April. Income for the student scholarship fund was \$13.
- WAAL received a grant for \$1,050 from the Worthington Arts Council. It will be use toward an art workshop. Date and time TBA. Search for a host artist is ongoing.
- Rules for holding raffles at our meetings were reviewed and found to be followed.
- WAAL received a bill for liability insurance in the amount of \$267. Elizabeth will confirm this amount due to questions about the invoice.
- The Spring Virtual Show is online. Checks for winners will be presented at the May general meeting. Winners' names were posted online.
- Process for awarding of student scholarships was discussed.

Worthington Art Fair: June 17th-18th
